

THE CHURCH, whose territorial boundaries are represented on this Map, numbers
 - since the union of the Old and New School - 33 SYNODS; 166 PRESBYTERIES;
 4,441 MINISTERS; 4,730 CHURCHES; and 468,164 MEMBERS. Taking the
 average of Communicants to Families, this would make a total under its special care
 and influence of over TWO MILLIONS of Souls. This leaves out the churches
 connected with the Southern Assembly, which are numerous in the Southern States.
