My dear friend

I trouble you once more with a communication of mine - I will be in Albany, if in health, about Tuesday 2nd of October - Should you think it proper to make a disposal of my things by auction I would like to have it when I am up - And would wish you to fix the day and give notice in time - The things must be some how disposed of, and I will have but little time to remain when I am up - on the morning of Tuesday I will be in Schuyler expecting a conveyance to Ballston, or Albany I have written to your brother James and to Old John Wilson so that if the Sacrament is to be dispensed arrangements may be made - You will have heard that I have a sweet son, a fine fellow, now 5 weeks old - With love to family Love Yours W.
