December the 6th 1747

I went to the Rev^d M^r Wheelock
of Lebanon Frank to learn some
ling of the Latin tongue, and
was there about a week, and was
obliged to come away from
there again to M^ohegan, and
stay'd about fortnight at M^ohegan
and then I returned up to M^r Wheelock
again, and some time towards
Spring again I went home to
M^ohegan, and stay'd near
three weeks before I returned
to M^r Wheelock again, and
August the 7th A.D. 1744 I went
away from Lebanon to M^ohegan
and I got so far as M^r B^r at
Norwich that Night, &
In the Morning I set out from
thence, and I got home to
M^ohegan just before Noon

(1744)

August the 15th I went from
Mohegan to Nahanantuck and
visited all the Indians, and I
returned Home again to Mohegan
in the 16th of D^r Instant, and so
immediately up to Mr Wheelock.
And September the 7th we set
out from Lebanon for New
Haven, and we got there in
the 10th of September, and there
we had the ^{pleas} of seeing the Scholars
Commist, and we returned home
again in the 2th of Sep:
and we got home again in
the 20th of D^r Instant

Nov: the 7th A. 1744 Da. O.
was taken Sick, and I went
Down to see him in the 12th
of D^r Instant, and I returned
again in the 17th of D^r Instant
to the Revd Mr Wheelock

January the 11th A. 1744
Got out from Lebanon

(1745)
for Mohegan and I got there
about Sun Set and the
next Day to Mathews at Coz
rah - and in the 14th of Sept
I returned again to the Red M^{ts}
Wheelocks. By the 23rd 1744
mater mea d. Quo sibi ejus
benierunt ad Dominum Wheelock
manere ibi Tempori, March 1st
20th 1745 I went from Seb^a
to Mohegan and I there st
Night and in the 4th of
April A.D. 1745 Joseph John
son and I went over to Groton -
and there we saw Joseph for
the first time that ever I saw
him, and we returned home
again in the 6th of Sept^{ber}
and in the 11th of April I re-
turned again up to Sebanon
and June 24th A. 1745 I went
Down to Mohegan and got
there that Day, and I ret^{ed}
again in the 14th of July to Seb^a

August the 20th 1745 I
went away from Xeb-
to Mohegan, and I returned
to Xeb^e again in 23 of
Instant - August the 20th
A: 1745 I set out from
Xeb^e for Norwich and
from thence to Plainfield
and so next from there to
Canterbury and Weds^{day} I
got to Windham, and this
day I got home to Xeb^e
Sept the 7th A: 1745 I set
out from Xeb^e for
Mohegan and there
some time before Night
the 10th of Sep^r we
we set out from Mohegan
for Nahanuck, and in
the 12th of I Instant returned
again to Xeb^e, and
in the 13th of Sep^r -

Many of us got out from
Mohegan for Long Island
and we got so far as New
London that Night, &
in the Morning we got
Sail from there, and we
got to the Place of our
Dessine in the Evening, and
some of us Lodg'd at Quill
Coyquam that Night,
and there we were very
kindly Entertained by all
of us, we had several
Meetings together, and
there was some Stir among
us. And in the 18th Sept
we all returned home,
again to Mohegan, and
to several Places where
we belonged, and we didn't
get home till 19th of
Sept. some time in the
Evening, and I spent

to Febr^y 23^d of Sep^r —

Dec^r of 16th 1745 we set
out from Lebanon Crank
for Windham, and we got
there at night, and I lodged
at Deacon Wheelock's at
Night, and the Next day
at Windham, and in ye
18th of Dec^r between 2 & 3 o'
Clock in the after Noon
the Poor Girl was Executed,
and I went right home to
Lebanon that Day —

May the 2^d 1746 I set
out from Crank for Mosegan
and I arrived there about
3 o' Clock in the after Noon
and I returned in 16th of May

August the 1st 1746 I
set out from Lebanon for Mose-
gan and got there before Night —
and returned again in the 8th of
August

August the 26th A. 1796

I went from Lebanon to More
and got there the same day

And I returned to L. again

the 27th of D^r last - April

of 5th 1797 went from Lebanon
to Moregan and got at night

April the 29th B. 1797 I return

to Lebanon - June 7th 1797

set out from Lebanon for

Moregan and got about 10 o'clock

in the afternoon -

June 25th we set out from

Moregan for N. Hanover,

and return from there again

to Moregan the 28th of D^r last -

and I returned to Lebanon 30th

of June - July 7th I

went to Lyford, and the next

Morning to N. Meadow and

from there I got back

to Ingham, and by right thro
to Winesport, and then to Hart
ford, and then from thence to
Frank again - July 17th
16th I went from F. to Moha
and got there the same Day
Tuesday August 14th 16th
I returned to Lebanon

From last Spring to this
Time I have left 11 weeks
last of I went from F. to
Mohan - and returned to
F. again, the 9th of 16th last
Nov 10th I left F. and
went Down to some
parts of New London, and
open school there at winter
ter - Must be 12th A 1713
I went up to Lebanon C. 17th
and got there about 30th 17th

in the after Noon
and March the 14th in
Hally and I set very early
in the Morning from He-
bron and got there a
bout 3 o C. — And March
the 16th I set out from Hebron
for Makegun and got there be-
fore Night — and came up
again to Hebron the 18th of 3
May the 22^d I went from He-
bron to Makegun — and re-
to Hebron again the 1st of
June — June 17th went from
Hebron to Makegun — and
returned again in the 22^d of
to 1st — August the 6th
Samuel Lee and I went from
Hebron to Makegun — August
the 10th I set out from Hebron
for Makegun and got there
before Night

and on the 11th of Sept I returned
 back to Hebron, and in the 13th
 of Sept I was at Mr Wheelocks
 on the 15th of Sept I went
 down to Mahegan and got there
 before Night - Sept. 15th
 we set out from Mahegan for
 Mahanick and we got there
 some time before Night -
 Sept the 21st I returned back
 to Mahegan - Oct the 3rd 1748
 I returned to Hebron, Oct
 the 6th I went down to Norwich
 and returned back to Hebron the
 same day Monday Nov^r 14th
 I went to Mr Wheelocks and
 went to Hebron same Day -
 Nov^r the 17th 1748 I set out from
 Mr Somers to Lebanon, intending
 to set out from there to Boston,
 but I was disappointed and so turned

my Course to Mr Wheelocks;
and Friday Novem^r 19 I set out
from Mr Wheelocks job Boston, and
got to far Mr Kingmans like
Wardham, and Lodges there and was
very kindly entertained, and Sat^r the
20th Novem^r the 19th set out from thence
on my Journey, and Staid at Mr
Moseleys in Scotland, about one
hour, and then went on and Staid
at Mr Williams in Pomfret, and
there tarried over the Sabbath and
was exceedingly well treated all
the while of stay there —

Novem^r the 21 Monday Morning
I set out from Pomfret on my
Journey Still and got to Upper
Hills which is 30 Miles this
Side Boston. Tuesday Novem^r
the 22nd as soon as it was Day
we set out from thence onwards,
and I left my Company by of
way, and I got to Achesons by
28 30 E. in the after Nook so
I wait to Boston, and Return
to Roxbury in the Evening and

Stayd at Capt. Williams & was
entertaind with all kindness the
Saturday Nov^r the 28th. I left
Foxbury, and Returne Home-
ward, and so far as Hatich
at Night, and Lodg'd at
Secⁿ Ephraims, and being
very receiv'd and entertain'd,
Next Day I went to their
Publick Worship, and found
too much evilly as I thought
and Monday I was visiting
amongst them and found
all very kind to a stranger.
Tuesday Nov^r the 29th I set
out from Hatich, and Jais
Chalkem and Isaac Ephraim
accompany'd me 3 or 4 miles
and so we parted.
