Saturday August 9th 1780
I set out from Mont^h for East
and got there before night and
staid at Mr. W. Keages that
and Monday just at night
I came a day from East and got
to Mont^h just after sun set
Monday Sept 10th 1780 I left
my school and to Kapeeq and
got there just after sun set
and we staid there in the night
Tuesday Sept 11th we set
out from Kapeeq for Long Island
for main and got over a
boat & staid in the after
noon and I staid at
at Stoning Town and
I set out from there
for where you & got
there some time in the
night and found most
of my relations well

Thursday Sept 17 20 1765
I set out from Monaghan, in
company with Col. M. Williams
just before 10 o'clock and rode
to Thames and was kindly entertained
and stayed till 2 o'clock in
the morning I set out from
hence to London and got to London
^{Wheatland's} before 10 o'clock and stayed
and Thames very well and
stayed here till 1 o'clock in
the morning I set out from
hence for Thames and got there just
after 10 o'clock and stayed
at London and Monaghan
the 21st I set out from Thames for
Monaghan and got there some time
in the night. I was Thames
Sept 22nd I set out from
Monaghan for Wheatland
and got there just before
10 o'clock and stayed
at London Thames & London
the 23rd I set out from
hence for Wheatland

and got there some time
in the Night Long
with one James Simon. It
was kindly entertain by my
friends G. B.

Wednesday 21st of 1750
I set out from Narayangset
for Narayangunk and got
there some time in the Night
and lodged at some wig-
wam and staying morning got
from there to New London,
and got there about 7 in the
morning, and from thence
I trail up to Molegon - and
Monday 28th I went Down to
New London in order to go
over to Long Island &c &c
The day was fair & was
a very pleasant ride the
day

and in light about 1000
at 10 o'clock I was from
Dorchester to Montauk and
got up here just before
trip at 10 o'clock and I got
from there directly for the
American Express and went on
among the people to get some
subject from and then I went
to New York and back again
to Indiana town and got there
in the evening &c

Saturday Oct 13 I went
from Montauk for East
and came from New York and
Monday Oct 15 I returned
to Montauk &c again

Thursday Oct 18 I got
out from Montauk for East
and came back to Montauk
Friday Morning we got a
way from here for the

renewed and he is ^{now} here at
a point of land about 11 miles west
of the main town, and in a good
the small beach at the point
my horses were put down by
the horses there till they got
Coulter's help. He has a relative
at Montauk again and he got
some about 4 or 5 days ago.
Wednesday November 17th 1770
I got out from Montauk

next day I heard Mr. Malby
preach, and was with some
in the after Noon, at Mr
Gulfsers, and tarry at Night
with Mr. Malby, and Monday
I part with him a Mr. Gulfer
and came a way some distance
home to Montauk, got there
at Night &c.

Saturday February of
9 1751 I went to E. Hill
and participate with them
the Sacrament of the Lords
and Tuesday February of
12 I returned to Montauk

I set out from Montauk for
Suffolkhampton and got there
some time before Night and
lived at Geo^{rs} M^r Buckles
Nights. Friday June 18th

John Albers Come to me from
Montauk, about 10 in the morning
and we immediately set out from
thence for Suffolkhampton, and
got there about 4 in the afternoon
and lived at Dea Tuls, and we
layd here amongst our Country
Men till Monday June 19th and
then we returned from thence to
wards Montauk, and we got there
some time before Night 19th
Sunday
