

May 1. 1785. Sabbath. 11  
Preached at Mr. Fitch's and  
there was a large number of  
well behaved people, and the  
word of God fell among the people  
with some weight, and some were  
repeatedly visited especially in the  
evening of the Day, after meet-  
ing, took dinner with the family  
and after that went home  
to some what spent, and went  
to bed soon.

May 10: a number of us went  
to Sunbrook to fishing, and returned  
met in the next Day, and we stayed  
at New London.

May 13: went on our way to  
go to the fishing, near night  
and we stayed there till 24  
and we had pretty good luck  
the 29. we got home and found  
our folks well.

Sabbath May 29: had meet-  
ing at Harveys, and we had a

a Penitential meeting, I sang a  
few words from the Brazen  
Serpent, and then felt the  
Pewee of God, I think.

June 5: had meeting at Haverhill  
and I spoke from Rom 4: 7

June 12: Sab: Henry and I  
went to Lawrence and I  
preached in Mr Rowben  
Palmers Meeting House and  
there was considerable num-  
ber of people, and they attend-  
ed with great solemnity, both  
parts of the Day, I spoke from

1 Sam 22: 2: and Rom 4: 7  
and after meeting went to Mr  
Carters, and took dinner there  
and after eating we set many  
feet home, and got a little  
after Sun 1st,

June 18: Henry and I went from  
Moseyan for Charles Town  
and we got a little before

Night, we put up at James  
Niles, and were kindly re-  
ceived by them, —

Sab: June 19: in the morning  
went to see old Samuell  
Niles, and found him very  
low, and I believe he never  
will get up again, went  
back to James, and then to  
the meeting House, and was  
a Number of People, but  
not large, they had but  
a Short Notice of my coming  
and I preached from Rom 4  
in the after Noon, we went  
to Sam Niles, and I preached  
from Daniel 5: 25 in the  
evening met at another House  
and John Cooper was there  
he spoke, and he discoursed of  
purity Spirit, afterwards I  
rehearsd the History of Joseph

and then returned to James  
Niles, and lodged there  
once more.

Monday June the 20: Sun  
a couple Hours high Deacon  
Henry Quinquand and I  
left Charter Town and went  
in Home ward, and we go  
Home some Time in the even-  
ing, found our Families  
Well — Sat. 26: went to  
New Concord, and Preach'd in  
M<sup>r</sup> Troops meeting House -  
from Mat 4: 10: in the after-  
noon from 1 Corin 16: 22 and  
was a large number people  
and they attended with great  
Solemnity, after meeting  
went to see M<sup>r</sup> Troop and  
found him in low State of  
Health, Supped with them  
and soon after Supper.

took leave of them and  
returned homeward, called  
at Mr. Jubay Croker, and  
found in him in hard sick-  
ness, full of pain & distress,  
prayed with him, and after  
Prayer went on, and I stop-  
ped at Mr. Fitcher and tarried  
there all night, next  
morning after breakfast  
went on and got home  
about 9 found my wife  
the Dropsy, she I heard in  
heard the baby Nawl, my  
poor Tuffi she is cold &  
Buried, the Lord the true  
reign of the universe  
Sanctify this Dispensa-  
tion to me and to all my  
Family

Tuesday June 29: a young  
man came to me from lower

most of groats in greatest  
distress of soul, I never saw  
any one thus long while and  
he desired I should go with him  
to groats vite a way, and I  
told him I could be there on the  
next day.

June 29; Rode down to new  
London, and so over to groats &  
a meeting at Mr. Burringtons  
and there was a goodly num-  
ber of people and they attend-  
ed the word with great solemn  
attention, and the young man  
that came to Mchegan for me  
was greatly affected, broke  
out in bitterness of soul, and  
cried for mercy, Several gave  
him a word of exhortation -  
I lodged in the same house

Thursday June 30: about 11  
Capt. Latham came to the H  
where I was, and I went Home  
with him civilly, Dined with  
him and his wife they

have no children; next a  
Court 3 went to Mr Giddins  
Saunders; and there <sup>was</sup> a num-  
ber of People got together &  
we began the worship of God  
Directly, and I preached to  
them, they gave an affectionate  
attention, and after I had  
finished speaking Mr. Avery gave  
a word of Exhortation and  
then he prayed and when he  
had done the People sat still  
and would not go away, it  
seem'd, they wanted to hear  
more, they were hungry af-  
ter the word, and so he gave  
out more Exhortations, and  
after a while they went a-  
way with heavy hearts, and  
some of them wanted I should  
preach to them again on  
the next Day, but I told them  
I wanted to get home to attend

upon other People, whom  
I had engaged, — Lodged at  
Mr Saunders, and was very  
kindly entertained, —  
Friday July 1: 1798 after  
breakfast to my leave of  
the Family in Peace and  
good Friendship; Call'd at  
Capt Robert Luthens but  
was not at Home, only his  
wife, staid there a while, and  
then went to the Ferry and  
went over to the City of New  
London, and so on home  
ward, got home about 3  
o: c: found found no one at  
Home —

July 3: 1795: on Sabb Got out  
Early in the morning for Pan  
quaker. M<sup>r</sup> Eliphaz Lister  
went with me, we got to the  
Place some Time before meet



Meeting Call on Elder Palmer  
and there took breakfast, &  
then we went to meeting and  
was considerable number of  
People, Mr Lister preached,  
and in the after Noon I  
preach, and towards night  
we went about 3 miles fur  
ther towards Colchester Town  
and there I preach again  
to a large number of People  
and both Elder Palmer's home  
there the Father and the Son  
and there hear to come attend  
on - after meeting went back  
with Mr Abel Palmer and I  
stopt at Mr Carters and lodged  
there, and had very agree-  
able conversation with Mr  
Carter and one of their  
Daughters, in Religious  
Concerns, went to bed late,

Monday July 4: got up very  
early and took my horse  
and went home - got home  
about 10: and found my  
getting ready to go to <sup>my</sup> ~~my~~  
muddy a fishing, and I took  
directly, got to the place before  
night -

July 9: Saturday went to New  
Concord, got to Deacons Huntingdon  
about 6:30, and was kindly  
received and entertained. Lodged there  
Sabb: July 10, Deacons Huntingdon  
and I went to meeting, and there  
was a great number people col-  
lected together, and I preached  
from Luke 12: 21: in the after-  
noon from John 12: 21: and they  
made me a collection, - towards  
evening preached at Deacons  
Huntingdon, - and soon after  
meeting I went to bed, but did  
not feel well, and was restless all  
night - July 11: got up early  
and they would have me stay

Breakfast, and I consented &  
after eating set off for home  
got Home about 10: and found  
all my Family well,

July 16 set off from Home for  
Preston, got to Seaman John Hays  
just after sun set, and kindly  
received by them Lodged there  
Sat. July 17: went to meeting  
with the Seaman, and Mr Parker  
Preached in the Morning,

in the afternoon I preached  
from

after I had  
Mr Park's name. The Sacra-  
ment of the Lords Supper, and  
I partook with them and it  
was a comfortable Season  
to the Children of God. Some  
old Christians broke forth in  
Praises and adorations to God  
and they encouraged one an-  
other to win their Kettle  
our Course, after meeting  
I went directly Home, went  
with Mr Story of Norwich

Stopt at his House, and took  
Supper with him, and was  
kindly treated, Soon after  
Supper I went on in of my  
and Home some Time in the  
Evening, and went to bed qui-  
etly. Thanks be to God for His  
goodness, to me and Family  
hitherto —

July 24: Sat: early in the  
Morning got up, and got ready  
and went down to Gallies Church  
and went over to Groton, to  
M<sup>r</sup> Sanders, and got there  
about 9: and was tenderly  
received by the whole Church  
about 10 the People began  
to gather, and there was a  
Number of People collected  
together, and I preached to  
them Luke 2: 11: and in  
the after noon from John 21: 22  
and I think had some assistance  
especially in the after noon —

and the People attended with  
great solemnity and affection  
I believe many felt the Power  
of the word, - I stayed at Mr  
Tardens, and had some Ever  
life with several, in the even-  
ing with my Christian Cord,  
and after that went to bed  
quietly - Monday after break-  
fast went off after taking affec-  
tionate leave of them, and stop'd  
at one Mr John Shoolers to see  
a Sicky Woman, found her  
very <sup>much</sup> weak both Body and  
Mind, I gave her some Coun-  
sell and w<sup>as</sup>t to believe on  
the Lord Jesus Christ, and  
pray'd with her and then  
w<sup>as</sup>t on my way, got  
near noon, and rested a  
few Minutes, and took Horse  
a gain and down to Kent  
London, to keep Court, and  
got home again some time  
in the evening -

Sabbath July 31 went to M<sup>rs</sup>  
and preached there twice from  
1 Corin 7: 29, 30 and 1 Corin 4: 7  
and there was not great many  
people and they attended well  
towards night I went to M<sup>rs</sup> <sup>Ray</sup>  
and preached there to a few people  
and as soon as the meeting was  
done, I went home, and got up  
about Daylight in

Sabbath Aug 7. Got up from  
Home and went to Upper part  
of Long bridge, got to M<sup>rs</sup> <sup>Hos</sup>  
near 10, and from there he  
went to M<sup>rs</sup> <sup>Woodworth</sup>, and there  
was a great Multitude of People  
and preached to them from  
Daniel, 5: 25 and John 8: 47  
Towards Night I preached at  
M<sup>rs</sup> <sup>Hos</sup> <sup>from 1 Corin 7: 29</sup> and there was great  
attention, and many were  
deeply affected, and some  
broke forth in Prayers, espe-  
cially in the Evening,

I Sailed at Mr. Moss, and  
Brother London a Negro  
preacher was with us all  
this Day, and this evening  
and he and several of the  
Young Christian Society at  
Mr. Moss. - Monday Morning  
we got up early in the  
morning, and London and  
I were taking off. But Brother  
would have us stay to break  
fast and we consented, and  
after breakfast we sang  
and Prayed, and the Power  
of God was done amongst  
us and the Young Christians  
were full with Love to God  
and to one another, and one  
of Brother Moss's Daughters  
who met with an unfortunate  
last Night was greatly  
filled with Divine Love  
and we had a blessed meet-  
ing, and he parted in  
Peace and Fellowship -

and I got Home about 12: and  
found my Family well the  
Lord be Prais'd.

Sab. Aug<sup>14</sup>: went from  
Home early in the morning for  
Long Society, got there before  
10 o'clock at Mr Jonathan Smiths  
and took Breakfast with them  
and then went to meeting  
and there was a great number  
of People and I preach'd to  
them from Heb: 4: 2: & 2: Cor<sup>1</sup>  
Some time after meeting  
I went Home, Stopt a while  
at Mr Exhains Store in the  
Langing, saw there I saw  
Brother London a Negro  
preacher and they was to  
a meeting in the evening  
and they want have me.  
Stay to meeting, but I did  
not, I got Home some time  
in the evening.



Thursday Aug 19: went  
to Mr. Joff's old Weavers Hill  
& sister Betty with me  
and preached to a number of  
people and they attended well  
with great sobriety. - after  
meeting I drank Tea with  
them, and then we set off for  
Home, got Home some time  
in the Evening. Thanks be  
to God -

Sat Aug 21: went from  
Home very Early in the Morning  
for Danforth, got there before  
Time before meeting, called on  
Mr. Carter, and was kindly re-  
ceived, by the Family, and took  
Breakfast, and after that  
went to meeting, and there  
was a goodly number of Hear-  
ers, and I preached to them, from  
Acts 2:37  
and the People attended with  
gravity and sobriety. Especially  
the Young People - soon after  
meeting I went Home and got  
it in the Dark of the Evening -

Sub. Augt 28. Got off from my  
House before ten o'clock and  
went on towards north part  
of Preston, got to Mr Daniel  
Hosier before meeting, and he  
went on to Mr Woodworths and  
found a great Number of People  
Collected together, and I pres<sup>ed</sup>  
to them, from Luke 10: 4 and  
Matt 11: 29. and there was great  
Solemnity and affection from  
after meeting, I went to brother  
Hosier and preached there before  
Night and there was a Crowd  
of People, from Luke 7: 23.  
Mr Hebert was there, and I Lodg<sup>d</sup>  
at the same House, Monday  
Augt 29. after Breakfast 13  
O'clock and I went to see Mr Hebert  
found him very kind and friend<sup>ly</sup>  
I went from there to Mr Joseph  
Cutnams and there I preached  
to a small Number of People  
but there was great solemnity  
among the People, took

There and after Dinner went  
to one Mr. Fitch's 3 or 4 miles  
and there I preached a great  
Number of People and the word  
of God fell with weight upon  
the People, and I believe they  
will not forget it soon —  
after meeting I went Home  
both of Mr. Fitch, a boat a  
mile and an Half East of  
Long Society Meeting House  
and there I lodged, and was  
very kindly treated —

Thursday Morning after  
Breakfast took leave of the  
Family and went on horse  
back, got Home just before  
noon and <sup>found</sup> no body at Home

May 3: Saturday towards night  
left Home, and went to lower part  
of Quilon, near Detain's Simeon  
alligates Ferry, and got over a  
Cord Iron pole, and descended to Mr  
Saunders before Daylight in  
and was received by the whole Town  
with all Kindness, lodged there

Sept 14: Sat about 10: a great  
number of people collected here  
then and I preached to them from  
John 11: 28: in the afternoon from  
1 Croni 29: 5: and gave out leav-  
ers, salmons, and silent attention  
the people look'd as if they were  
arriv'd before the Judgement  
Seat of God, I believe they felt  
the Power of the Truth of the word  
of God, - Soon after meeting I  
din'd with the People of the House  
and then I went to see Mr. Valey  
I walk'd about 3: miles Southward  
I got home about Sun set, I had  
no thought of having a meeting  
but presently after I got home  
2 or 3 Neighbours bore home and  
they chipp'd among themselves &  
presently they ask'd me whether I  
would preach if Neighbours  
would come in, and I told them  
I would I would, and then, <sup>sent</sup> out  
to give notice, and in about  
half an hour a number of People

Came in to see to fill a large room  
or almost, and I spoke to them  
from John 4: 10. and the people  
attended well. Lodged here this night  
and was kindly entertained. Monday  
Sept 23rd in the morning I got up  
and had my horse latched, and I set off  
and directed my horse to Capt Robert  
Lathams get them just as they were  
getting breakfast ready, I sat down  
with them, after eating I went to  
Mr William Sheffield, I had a little  
temporal business with him, but  
I found him not at home, just gone  
from home, - and so I went back  
to Capt R. Lathams, took dinner  
with them, and after dinner took  
leave of em, and went to wait  
to Mr Sheffield again and he was  
at home, I did my business  
with him; and directly went  
to the Ferry, met my good  
friend Mr Saunders, and he  
gave me a piece of money &  
I was very loth to take it but  
he would make me take it

and so I was oblig'd to it, and the  
good Lord reward him and his  
family a Thousand fold, —  
went down to the City of New London  
met M<sup>r</sup> Smith and had our  
Business, and so he proved in  
good Friendship — I went one  
very long, and Sept at Long Beach  
and lodged there — Tuesday M<sup>r</sup>  
got off very early, and got home  
and more well, and he <sup>was</sup> <sup>well</sup>  
much better, what was at it  
were well, the Lord he praised  
for his goodness to us. Transfer —

The Sabbath Sept 11 got up very early  
in the Morning and set off from home  
and went to Long Beach, got there  
some time before the People about  
Sept of M<sup>r</sup> John Smith, as kindly  
received, near 11. Went to the House  
of Worship and there a great Num-  
ber of People and attended with great  
and solemn attention, — Preach'd  
from Isa. V. 3:4 & 1 Peter 4:24  
Directly after meeting, I both

Mr. Pitch and eat with them, and  
after eating went to Mr. Brown's &  
presented them to a considerable num-  
ber of people and they behaved well  
I took much ground in left that  
day & spoke from Lament 3: 40  
Lodge at the same house, and was  
highly entertained. On Monday I  
early got up and got my mail  
and went on, stop at Mr. Pitch's  
and took breakfast with them, and  
soon after I went on Halloway, and  
I got about 11: found my family  
but no company, had some things  
brought me on, and stayed at the  
Holly House — Rested a while &  
a boat 3: in the afternoon took  
my way, made a gain, and went  
to Nahantick in Lyme, to see the  
fish, got to Rope town just after  
sunset, and heard very true  
widow Hannah Justice was  
Dead and buried. The dead taken  
right and buried on Sabbath  
got to the Indian town in the  
dusk of the evening, found my  
Cousin June his wife and all  
his children sitting porch

all very rich - Prayed with them  
and their house with Cousin  
Joseph, and Lodged there,  
Tuesday, after ~~the~~ found some  
Family little early, saw some  
other take - about 12. I preached  
in Cousin Joseph's House to few  
People - about 3: - Got off for  
Home, got home just after  
Daylight in

Saturday Sep<sup>r</sup> 14. Some time  
in the afternoon left Home and  
went to Proston, got to Deacon  
Steeves in the dusk of the evening  
and was affectionately received  
by him and Lodged there,  
Wed. 19. about 10 went to M.  
and there was a considerable  
number of People - M<sup>r</sup> Park  
preached in the Morning, and  
in the after I preached from  
Luke concerning the Prodigal  
Son - Singly after - In the  
M<sup>r</sup> Park administered the ordi-  
nances of the Lords Supper.



and I parted with them some  
more, and finally after I  
went the Indian Town of Grotto  
with Jo: Infirmore, and had  
a meeting there, and I believe  
the Lord with present with us  
the Christians have much  
moved. Some Time in the  
evening we broke the mill  
and after a while I went  
to bed quietly - the Lord be  
praised - Monday, Sep<sup>r</sup> 19

Set off for Home early in the morning  
after I took good leave of the Family  
got home about noon, found my  
well. - - - - - - - - - - - - - - -  
Thursday a boat I in  
the morning set off from Home, for  
Croydon, and went up to town  
of Canterbury got to Mr. Clark's  
about 3. in the afternoon, and  
the people had got together and  
Mr. Clark had begun the meeting  
he was at dinner, and I preached  
and there was great solemnity &  
affection, and many tears flow  
down freely. - - - - - - - - - - -  
went with Mr. Clark to his house

and took Dinner with them -  
and the People collected together  
again in the evening, in M<sup>r</sup>  
Purke's House, and we had a  
comfortable meeting, many were  
melted down with Love, and  
they broke out in exultation &  
Praise, and some time in the  
evening we parted in Love, Peace,  
and Fellowship in Divine Fellowship  
and then went to bed remembering  
the Lord be Praised -

Friday Sep<sup>r</sup> 23 had a little  
Exercise with my Lord, with M<sup>r</sup>  
Family, and it was comfortable  
dear with us, and after break-  
fast I took Brotherly leave of  
them, and went on my way  
and got to M<sup>r</sup> Post's <sup>at about 1</sup> and  
took Dinner, and about 3 I set off  
again, just call on M<sup>r</sup> Pomroy  
and to pass on, and got to  
M<sup>r</sup> Post's a little of <sup>the</sup> <sup>same</sup> <sup>kind</sup> <sup>of</sup> <sup>meeting</sup> <sup>at</sup> <sup>his</sup> <sup>house</sup>, and I was very kind-  
ly entertained - Saturday Morn-  
ing he set off early in the  
Morning, and went on over-land,  
got to Esq<sup>r</sup> Welles, about 10

Sat a while, and Exp Beesbury  
urgent to have me. My an of  
Sabbath, but I could not, and so we  
went on, and it was rainy kind  
of the weather, just before they let me  
go to Indian Male in Farmington  
and put up at Daniel Mopsh, &  
the Indians were well, there were  
but eight Families of Indians -

Sabbath Sep 23. Preached 3 Times,  
many white People were together  
and they attended well - here I met  
with George Throok and his Family  
from Long Island, they have moving  
up to Orange County,

Monday Sep 26. We set off about  
9. and got to Brother Phineas  
about 2: and here I had the dole  
ful account of the Death of my  
Daughter Sabitha, a mortal  
and heavy addition to all Trouble,  
and sorrow, went to see my poor  
Daughters youngest Child, and  
it was a horrid and very  
affecting sight - went and  
had a meeting with the People  
on the next day twice, and the  
People came very solemn -

This Night Lodged at one Mr  
Safford's the woman is extraordi-  
nary in Christianity of great  
understanding, and Experience  
Wednesday Sept 28 Got of early  
having taken leave of the Town  
and I went on my way, Got  
at Brothers Thins took break  
fast with them, Mr Willson  
was with me a son in Law  
to old uncle Chauncer, soon  
after eating took leave of the  
family and he went on our  
way, then at Mr Chauncer's  
and here Mr Woodbridge the  
Breacher among this People  
overtake me, and was extream-  
ly urgent to have me stay to  
preach once more but  
I denyd him, and we pass  
on, he went with us a little  
way and then parted in Road  
and he went on, and got  
to Canaan just Night and  
we went to Mr Joseph Mough  
a minister of the Gospel

and Lodged there since  
his wife being poorly with  
Lameness -

Thursday Sep<sup>r</sup> 29 got up very  
early and set off and got Northbridge  
about 3 in the afternoon, and  
called at Capt<sup>r</sup> Yokes, but he was  
not at Home, and most all the  
Indians were sent, but there  
left of those that are gone up to  
Onoyda - about two thirds of them  
are gone up to Onoyda - just be-  
fore time I'll want to see Mr  
Kirkland, and was a little while  
and then returned, call on Mr<sup>r</sup> Seigo  
and Lodged there, Mr<sup>r</sup> Seigo was  
not at Home -

Friday Sep<sup>r</sup> 30 after Breakfast  
went back to Capt<sup>r</sup> Yokes, and  
was there some time, and then  
set off, - I stopt a while at a  
Tavern, and here I met with  
one Capt<sup>r</sup> Baldwin of New Canada  
and he wryd to have me stop at  
his place to have a meeting in  
the evening, and I consented, and

went on to Richmond, and got  
there before noon. Stopt at Mr  
Millers, and old acquaintance  
of mine, found them all well,  
and with them, and soon after  
Dinner went on our way, and  
got to New Canaan just before  
Sun set, call'd and told Whiting  
he was busy, and so I y<sup>e</sup> afternoon  
reach'd Capt Buldwin, in the  
Evening the People began to ga-  
ther and there was a great Num-  
ber of People collected, and I  
preach'd to them, from Exod  
the words, go forward & stand I  
had but little sense of Divine  
thing, yet the People attended  
with gravity - Lodged at the  
Same House, —

Saturday, Oct 1: 1785 - Got up  
early, and stopt at Mr Coys  
and took Breakfast with him  
and sent of James before me -  
after a while I set off, and about  
11 o c call'd at a publick House  
the mans Name was Robinson

and he pursued me under some o-  
thers, and another came in, and  
they began to importune me  
w<sup>th</sup> a long hand to have me  
stop to keep Sabbath there, I  
was a man desired me before  
to go so far as to green Bush  
and Mr. Cump<sup>t</sup> desired me also  
to stop there and keep Sabbath  
at one Esq<sup>r</sup> Woodworths, - and  
finily consented to stop at Mr.  
Robinsons to preach there  
in the Morning, and so go to  
green Bush in the after noon  
and to lodge in Mr. Robin-  
son. The Place is call'd  
Phillips Town

Sabbath Octo<sup>r</sup> 2: The People  
collected together, and there was  
a great Assembly, and I preach<sup>ed</sup>  
to them from 1 Ep<sup>l</sup> V: 12: and  
then after meeting took dinner  
and then went of to Esq<sup>r</sup> Wood-  
worths in green Bush, Mr.  
Robinson, and another gentle

went with me, and he got  
there about 4 P. M. and there  
was Number of People got to  
gether, and I began the Service  
Directly, and there w. solemn  
attention, - The People collected  
Some thing for me, Lodged in  
here this Night and was here  
by entertainment, - here I met Mr.  
Hally from Norwich he is  
preaching in a Place called  
New Bethelham - in the  
Evening a Number of us had  
a agreeable Exercise with my  
Christian Cards and after that  
went to bed Quietly -

Monday Oct. 3; Was at Esq.  
till 12 then went to New Bethel  
Stopt at M<sup>r</sup>. Townsends and  
there took dinner, and then  
went on, Got to the Place a  
bout 2. and a great Number  
of People had got together, and  
began the meeting Service, and  
I went to the Church at 4 P. M.
