all. Sabbath May 8<sup>th</sup>  
held a meeting with them  
again all day & I  
preaching & some other

word - Monday May 17<sup>th</sup>  
I be came seaward and  
had a short Meeting at  
Mr Henry Haven's, and  
the People seem'd to attend  
with good attention, and  
from thence he went to  
Moriches, and had <sup>met</sup> at Ben  
Castles Kingian, and in  
the morning May 19<sup>th</sup>  
he set out from thence to  
renew home and to so far  
as Thencecock, and had  
a meeting there with  
Indians, but nothing re-  
markable appeared a-  
mongst them. Wednesday  
May 20<sup>th</sup> he set out  
from thence and got
