MINUTES OF SESSION.

The installation of the pastor, William D. Nelson took place in the evening June 25, 1874, in Memorial Chapel. The services were opened with singing. Prayer was then offered by Rev. F. J. Crosby, which was followed by reading of the Scriptures by Rev. W. H. Swift, after which a sermon was preached from Luke 2nd Chapter and 14th verse by Rev. R. M. Putnam of Philadelphia. The charge to the Pastor was then delivered by Rev. A. D. (sic) Plummer, and the charge to the people by Rev. W. H. Swift of Pittsboro. Prayer was then offered followed by singing, after which the congregation was dismissed with the benediction by the newly installed pastor, Rev. W. D. Nelson.
